We are proud to present the 45 grants totaling \$660,000 approved by the Bronxville School Foundation for the 2017-2018 school year. Many of these grants were already in place as the students returned to school this September, providing immediate benefit to Bronxville students in all three schools.



Since our formation 27 years ago, the Foundation's mission has been to enhance the quality of public education in our community by engaging the support and energies of educators, citizens, parents, students, and alumni. Thanks to the consistent and very generous support of our donors, this mission has become a reality as more than 720 grants totaling more than \$9.6 million have been funded by the Foundation. The Classroom of Tomorrow

The Bronxville School Foundation is committed to investing in the cutting edge curriculum, equipment and tools that create a 21st century classroom.



Television Studio

Studio B has been transformed into a state-of-the-art TV studio that provides exciting media opportunities for our middle and high school students. Filming and production of Bronco TV now takes place in a space that mimics

a professional newsroom. Students have the opportunity to learn all aspects of the production process in this exciting new space.



College Tours Via Virtual Reality Headsets

There are a number of limitations that prevent high school students from visiting colleges – time being one of the biggest hurdles for many students. These virtual tours are another useful tool for students to make more informed decisions in a less stressful environment.

Innovative Furniture

Classrooms equipped with innovative furniture provide our students with a flexible learning environment that promotes collaboration, problem solving and independence. These responsive, dynamic environments reflect life outside the traditional classroom setting.

Through the use of this furniture, students adapt the classroom to best fit their needs and create the most optimal space for achieving their goals.







Mandarin Language Class via Remote Teacher

The High School Introductory Mandarin Chinese I course is an online synchronous learning program that provides high quality language instruction through a technologyrich video conferencing model. Bronxville

students are located onsite and are instructed by a highly trained teacher of the Orange-Ulster BOCES Mandarin Chinese Department. This opportunity not only provides high quality instruction in Mandarin, but also introduces an alternative method of instruction that has the potential to shift the paradigm in terms of what is possible in a small high school.

The Foundation exists to fund important and innovative projects the District budget cannot cover. These enhancements are vital to creating an excellent overall educational experience for our children and keeping our school competitive.

Our Future

The Foundation's work is more critical than ever given the constraint of the NY state tax cap on District revenues. It is only through the ongoing and generous support of the community that we will keep our school and village strong.



What Differentiates Us

The Foundation and the PTA play different, but complementary, roles at Bronxville School. The Foundation funds grant requests, primarily from teachers and administrators, for faculty training, curriculum enhancements, and upgrades to equipment and facilities. The PTA serves as a vital link between the school and parents to support communication, after-school enrichment programs, and athletic and community traditions.



Foundation projects touch every student, elevating their educational experience in academics, the arts, athletics and student support services.

The Foundation enhance excellence at our school by helping maintain the competitive advantages that help keep our community strong and support fulfillment of the Bronxville Promise.



What We Do

The Foundation's 30-member volunteer board works with teachers, the administration, students and parents to identify innovative ideas that will have the greatest impact on the most students. The Foundation board performs extensive due diligence on grant proposals. To fund those ideas, the Foundation raises money each year from school families, alumni and community members.



What's Compelling

Foundation funds have direct and immediate impact by making many cutting-edge curricular and technology improvements possible.

The grants are fast and flexible — many projects funded in May are up and running in classrooms in time for the new school year.



School & Community Impact

The Foundation positively impacts all three schools by supporting academics, arts, athletics, student support services, and faculty. By maintaining vital connections with alumni and the broader Bronxville community, the Foundation provides a means for all constituents to partner for Bronxville School's progress.

Ways to Give

Most donors give during our annual fund drive in the fall when Foundation board members send letters out to the community, but gifts are made throughout the year. We also sponsor the *Katie Welling Memorial Run*, a great community event on the Saturday of the Thanksgiving holiday. Alumni support the Foundation through the *Alumni Fund-Raising Drive* and the *Alumni Brick Walk* in which alumni (or their families) purchase inscribed pavers for the brick walk in front of the school. Gifts can be in the form of cash, securities, or life insurance. Some donors give "In Memory Of," "In Recognition Of," "In Honor Of," or as planned Gifts/Bequests.

Thanks to the generosity of our community, total contributions for 2018 were \$530,346.
